



Mile End Mill Paddler's Agreement

White Water Risk

I confirm I understand that white water paddle sport carries inherent risks, and I will do everything within my ability to mitigate those risks including, but not limited to: - Paddling only within my (and my group's) abilities.

Any downstream boat losses must be reported to the police immediately.

I will operate within the scope of my qualifications and confirm that I am able to safely lead my group through any rapids or features on the Mile End Mill section of the River Dee.

Safety Equipment

I will carry and I know how to correctly use any safety equipment that I take with me.

I confirm that my own as well as my clients craft is in good repair and is designed and manufactured for the purpose of white-water paddling. I will ensure that all my group are briefed and are confident in how to exit their craft as well as how to swim in a moving water environment.

I will minimise snag hazards wherever possible on boats/boards and equipment/clothing.

When Paddling, I will be leading a group (following COVID rules or social distancing rules) and operate peer safety/rescues.

I will Inform the police if any craft are lost downstream.

PPE

I will wear a CE Approved helmet & buoyancy aid whilst partaking in activity on the Mile End Mill site. As well as ensuring that those within my care also do.

Site Rescue

I will follow all site rules and I understand that no safety cover or instruction is provided by TNR Outdoors Ltd.

I am solely responsible for my own actions and those within my coaching group.
